

Notes on Tickets, Passes and Transfers.

- SEAT will continue to honor tickets purchased prior to September 6, 2016, and no additional fare will be required.
- One Day Unlimited Ride passes may be purchased on the bus.
- Multi-Day Unlimited Ride Passes and Multi-Ride Tickets must be purchased at SEAT or other sales locations.
- Advance Purchase Multi-Day Unlimited Ride passes are activated upon first use on the bus, and are valid for consecutive days.
- Unlimited Ride Passes are for individual use only, and will not be accepted when presented by multiple individuals (no "pass back").
- Transfers will be issued upon fare payment, NOT at the end of the line.
- Transfers are valid anywhere in the SEAT system until the expiration time is reached.
- Transfers are not accepted on the bus from which they are issued.
- All sales are final; SEAT will not issue cash refunds.
- Valid ½ Fare ID's or a MediCARE (not Medicaid) card must be presented for the Senior/Disabled fare or use of the Senior/Disabled ticket.

About SEAT

SEAT is a multi-jurisdictional public transit agency created by the local municipalities and state ordinances. SEAT is not a state agency. SEAT consists of nine member towns: East Lyme, Griswold, Groton, Lisbon, Montville, New London, Norwich, Stonington and Waterford.
